Covid-19 Outreach Worker (30 hours/week)

The position will be primary support for our Covid-19 Response Program. Working and connecting with the local community to determine supports and resources for Indigenous people affected by Covid19 and requiring supports to stay healthy and housed.

This person will be connected to resources in community and respond to emergency situations due to Covid-19 and other housing related concerns. This is a temporary position to March 31, reporting to the Covid-19 Response Coordinator.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Sound understanding of issues related to lack of affordable housing, mental health issues and addiction.
- Know how to access available housing, resources, related agencies, and government programs in the GVRD
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills to connect with and establish trusting relationships with at risk Indigenous people.
- Exercise discretion, compassion, empathy and maintain confidentiality.
- Results focused to meet high standards of performance.
- Ability to build organizational trust in his or her own professionalism, integrity, and expertise.
- Knowledge and understanding of Aboriginal cultures, traditions, and an ability to work with culturally diverse people.
- Familiarity with Urban Indigenous, First Nation, Metis and Inuit communities in Vancouver.
- An understanding of issues and challenges facing Indigenous people choosing to move to urban centers is an asset.
- Must have or be able pass a vulnerable sector clearance with VPD.
- Valid BC Driver's license in good standing and access to a reliable vehicle is required.
